

Dinner Money – ParentPay

St Mary's Catholic High School operates an e-payment system for the collection of dinner money. This means that we cannot accept cash or cheques in school. ParentPay has been received positively by our parents/carers.

You will be able to check your child's account balance at any time by logging onto www.parentpay.com and entering your user name and password, which will be supplied by the school. ParentPay can also help you set up a "low credit" amount as a reminder.

For your child to buy a school dinner it is important to keep the account in credit. If payment has not been received into your child's account by 10.00 am, our school policy allows us to offer a student a sandwich for that day, on the understanding that the cost of the sandwich will be cleared when the account is again in credit. Should you be unable to top up your ParentPay account, please provide your child with a packed lunch until any debt is cleared.

If you have any queries or if you have difficulty making payment please contact the school office to discuss this further. Please read the frequently asked questions overleaf which shows the available payment options.

ParentPay FAQs

- **When can I log in to my account?**

Once you have received your activation letter from school with your activation login details, you will be able to activate your account and start making payments. This letter will be sent to you by school.

- **Which cards can I use?**

ParentPay accepts MasterCard and Visa credit cards, and Maestro, Switch, Delta, Electron, Solo and Visa debit cards. Some schools may limit the use of credit cards for some transactions; you will be informed by the school directly of any such restrictions.

- **Is it safe to make payments on the internet?**

Yes. ParentPay uses leading technology to process your card transactions securely. All communication with the bank is encrypted and neither ParentPay nor the school have access to your card details.

- **How can I check that it is secure?**

Standard website addresses begin with *http*; the address for a secure site will always begin with *https*. You will also see a padlock at the bottom/top right of the screen on our login page and after you have logged into your account; never enter your card details or personal data on any web page whose address does not start *https*.

- **What about our personal information?**

ParentPay holds a limited amount of information about you and your child solely for the purpose of administering your account; ParentPay does not use your personal information other than for supporting the school. The systems are operated under strict guidelines set out by the Data Protection Act 1998.

ParentPay will NEVER contact you by phone, email or mail and ask you to divulge confidential information like passwords or card numbers. If you are ever contacted by someone claiming to be from ParentPay, please telephone immediately on 0845 257 5540

- **I don't have a home PC so how can I use ParentPay?**
