

## Important Dates for University application

March - September	Attend Open Days and carry out research into different courses and institutions. Lots of weekend open days available if students are well prepared. Calendar of open days issued in school.
May/June 2019	Log on to UCAS and start application.  Enrol for UCAT. Check if your course requires you to do any extra test, e.g. BMAT LNAT etc.
July/August 2019	Complete all sections of UCAS form except choices and personal statement. Write draft personal statement.
September 2019	Early Applicants ( <i>those applying to Oxford, Cambridge, all medicine, dentistry and veterinary science courses</i> ) need to have their UCAS forms complete and a draft of their personal statement ready for editing. Early applicants should check with Mrs Jackson (Examinations Officer) to ensure they are entered for any tests run in school. This must be done before 1 October.
13 September 2019	Early Applicants - Deadline for requesting references from Mrs Hogan in the Admin Office.
<b>27 September 2019</b>	<b>Early Applicants submit completed UCAS form to Mrs Hogan.</b> You must meet this deadline but your UCAS form can still be altered after this. Until you pay and send your application, you are able to make changes to it. Keep checking your school email for messages.
<b>9 October 2019</b>	<b>PAY &amp; SEND by this date.</b>
15 October 2019	UCAS deadline for early applicants. Applications must arrive at UCAS by 18.00 WITH REFERENCE ATTACHED.
16 November 2019	Standard application - deadline for requesting references from Mrs Hogan in the Admin Office.
<b>25 November 2019</b>	<b>All completed UCAS forms to be submitted to Mrs Hogan.</b> You must meet this deadline but your UCAS form can still be altered after this. Until you pay and send your UCAS application, you are able to make changes to it. Keep checking your school email for messages.
September onwards	Applicants will receive offers or notice of rejection. Some universities make offers early, others later. This has nothing to do with the quality of your application. You may be invited to an applicant day, like an open day but for applicants holding offers. You do not have to accept or decline the offers at this point.
<b>8 January 2020</b>	Standard Applications – <b>PAY &amp; SEND by this date.</b>
<b>15 January 2020</b>	<b>UCAS deadline for majority of courses.</b> Applications must arrive at UCAS by 18.00 WITH REFERENCE ATTACHED.
25 February 2020	UCAS Extra opens. If you have been rejected by all five of your initial choices, UCAS Extra gives you a chance to apply for courses with vacancies.
March 2020	Start your student finance application. Make sure you <b>apply for funding for the correct academic year (2020/21)</b> . Don't worry if you have not made a firm or insurance choice. You can change the institution on your application right up to results day.
31 March 2020	Most offers will have been received by now.
1 May 2020	For most applicants, you must reply to your offers by this date but it is very important to follow UCAS as some courses need you to respond earlier.
<b>13 August 2020</b>	<b>A/AS Level results day and start of clearing.</b> Adjustment opens for candidates who have gained better results than they expected.
