FOR THOSE WISHING TO FOLLOW A LEVEL COURSES AT ST MARY'S

We would expect you to have gained at least five GCSEs with grade 4 or above. In addition you will need to have met the criteria in the prospectus for your chosen A level subjects usually including grade 6 or above in relevant GCSE subjects.

Uniform:

Monkhouse will be available in school **Wednesday 3 July** from 1.00 pm until 6.00 pm if you want to come along and try on items of uniform before you buy. Students are not required to purchase all items in the new list straight away. If you have items which are in line with our current PE kit that are still able to be worn these items will be permitted, however, all future replacements will need to be in line with the new PE kit list (see overleaf). The Sixth Form tie (£7.50) and Sixth Form planner (£5.00) are **essential** and available only from reception - you can purchase these on results day (cash only please).

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UNIFORM School suppliers: www.monkhouse.com *Words and phrases in italics indicate areas where students will have to accept staff judgement.*

GIRLS	ITEM	NOTES
Skirt	Navy blue, knee length, box pleat skirt purchased from Monkhouse.	Worn no higher than just above the knee (1 inch maximum)
Shoes	Plain black, <i>sensible</i> shoes. Flat or with a small heel.	No suede or canvas shoes. No open toed sandals or sling back shoes. No extremely thick sole. No logos. <i>Sharply pointed heels</i> not allowed. <i>Big heels</i> (inside measurement over 3cm) not allowed.
Tights	Navy or flesh coloured.	From 1 May until October half term girls may choose not to wear tights and can wear white ankle socks instead.
Shirt	Plain, white, <i>formal</i> school shirt (long or short sleeve).	Must be tucked into skirt. Must not be <i>over fitted</i> .
Tie	Sixth Form Tie.	Must be fully up to the neck with shirt top button fastened.
Blazer	Standard, navy blue school blazer with school badge sewn to top pocket.	
Pullover	Navy blue, long sleeve, V-neck pullover.	Not a compulsory item of uniform.
Coat	<i>Smart</i> , navy or black formal coat.	Not a compulsory item of uniform. Must be no shorter than the blazer.
Hats and Gloves	Navy blue/black and <i>in keeping with school uniform</i> .	
Jewellery	A <i>small amount of discrete</i> jewellery allowed. Stud or ring anywhere else but ear lobes not allowed.	Earrings: only one small earring per ear; these to be worn in the earlobe.
Make-up	<i>Subtle</i> make up allowed. No false eyelashes or lash extensions. <i>Natural</i> nail coloured varnish only allowed.	<i>Heavy</i> use of make-up not allowed. No coloured nail varnish.
Hair	Hair should look <i>smart and professional</i> with no extremes in styling.	<i>Subtly</i> enhanced natural colour tolerated but <i>significant</i> colour changes not allowed.
Badges	Responsibility group or charity badges only.	
Bags	Predominantly blue or black and <i>in keeping with the school uniform</i> .	<i>Bright or over-patterned</i> school bags not allowed.
Mobile phones	Not permitted for these to be seen in main school areas.	Allowed in exclusively sixth form areas. Must be switched off in lessons and around school.
PE Kit	Monkhouse polo shirt, navy blue shorts, ¼ zip training top all with school logo. Monkhouse navy blue leggings (<i>optional and worn at teacher's discretion as an undergarment in winter months</i>). Navy blue football socks for hockey/football etc. White ankle socks for netball/athletics etc. Suitable outdoor trainers for the courts and all weather pitch (not moulded). Shoes	Plain black, <i>sensible</i> shoes.	No suede, canvas or cotton. No extremely thick soles. No logos. Desert shoe/boot styles are unacceptable.
Socks	Plain grey, navy or black.	
Shirt	Plain, white, <i>formal</i> school shirt (long or short sleeve).	Must be tucked into trousers.
Tie	Sixth Form Tie.	Must be fully up to the neck with shirt top button fastened.
Blazer	Standard, navy blue school blazer with school badge sewn to top pocket.	
Pullover	Navy blue, long sleeve, V-neck pullover	Not a compulsory item of uniform.
Coat	<i>Smart</i> , navy or black <i>formal</i> coat	Not a compulsory item of uniform. Must be no shorter than the blazer.
