Dear Year 13 Students, Parents and Carers

I do hope you are safe and well. It seems such a long time ago now that you left school so suddenly on that Leavers' Day back in March, and although we have been staying in touch remotely, we are now in a position where we can offer some face-to-face interaction in school.

Firstly, we need to give you a safe opportunity to return your textbooks/resources for your A level/BTEC subjects. This will be **Friday 19th June** and we would ask you to arrive according to the following staggered schedule.

09:00-10:00	13GC and 13HS/PN
10:00-11:00	13DG and 13SP
11:00-12:00	13HY and 13AN
12:00-13:00	13GS and 13KN
13:00-14:00	13LM and 13PL
14:00-15:00	13KK and 13KH

On arrival you will register with me at the Drama Hall Foyer and tell me what books you are dropping off. You will then pass through the Drama Hall and place books/resources at the appropriately marked subject zone.

On exiting the Drama Hall by the side door you will be issued with your Yearbook, if you have ordered one, and Miss Errington/Mrs Smith will note your receipt of the book. If you do not have any resources to return, but have ordered a Yearbook, please still attend on this day to collect it.

At all times you must adhere to social-distancing rules both queuing outside the Drama Hall if necessary and also after exiting the Drama Hall. I understand the temptation will be great to loiter and catch up with friends but you must not do this and we will sadly have to enforce your departure from the school site if this was to be the case.

If you cannot return books that day because of other commitments, but one other person can, on your behalf, please let me know your nominated person by **Friday 12th June**. Otherwise I will be expecting to see you on the 19th June.

I would of course like to offer greater flexibility but cannot at this time. The logistics of running the school presently are so complex and so I would ask for your full cooperation with this and adhere to your time slot as much as possible.

You will be receiving another letter soon regarding A level Results Day on the 13th August.
