Dear Year 13 Students and Parents/Carers

As we are approaching the summer I wanted to write to you to let you know the arrangements for coming into school to collect your results on **Thursday 13 August**.

Students can collect their results from the Drama Hall. We do **urge you to be present in person on results day** in case there is a need to contact universities or obtain help from our staff.

There will be a staggered collection time to stay safe:

8am to 10am – students who hold **conditional** firm/insurance offers from universities for 2020 entry

10am to 11am – students who hold **unconditional** firm/insurance offers for 2020 entry

11am to 12pm – students who have other plans

We will be using a one way system as we did when you returned your books: on arrival you will enter via the Drama Hall Foyer and collect your results envelope, you will then pass through the Drama Hall. Please be aware that queuing outside is likely so bring an umbrella should the weather be inclement.

On exiting the Drama Hall by the side door you will register with Miss Errington who will make a note of your destination (if already confirmed via UCAS Track – due to go live at 8am). If you need advice she will be able to direct you to the appropriate staff. If you wish to open your results away from the Drama Hall we ask you to do so safely and return via the one way system to register with Miss Errington. It is important that we know that each of you has secured their next step, especially in such uncertain times.

At all times you must adhere to social-distancing rules both queuing outside the Drama Hall if necessary and also after exiting the Drama Hall. I understand the temptation will be great to loiter and catch up with friends but you must not do this and we will sadly have to enforce your departure from the school site if this was to be the case.

Unfortunately we cannot accommodate parents/carers on site so if they do come along with you they must wait on the bus bay.

If you are happy with your confirmed choice via UCAS Track that morning, we would appreciate you arriving after 9am to avoid unnecessary queueing required by social distancing protocol.


Help and Advice
