Dear Year 11 Students and Parents/Carers

For those of you who are Sixth Form applicants I hope you enjoyed your Virtual Transition Day.

Following my previous letter I am writing to let you know the amended arrangements for coming into school to collect your results on **Thursday 20 August** and to enrol for Sixth Form where applicable.

Students can collect their results from the Drama Hall where Miss McKay and Miss Hood will oversee this. There will be a staggered collection time to stay safe:

We will be using a one way system in the Drama Hall: on arrival you will enter via the Drama Hall Foyer and then pass through the Drama Hall collecting your results envelope.

On exiting the Drama Hall by the side door you will confirm your intention regarding your destination with Dr Dando. Those students enrolling for Sixth Form at St Mary's will be directed to VIVA to a socially distanced waiting area and students will be called through to enrolment appointments with the enrolment team. Sadly this year for obvious reasons we cannot invite parents/carers onto the school site for enrolment appointments but the confirmation of enrolment will be emailed to parents.

At all times you must adhere to social-distancing rules both queuing outside the Drama Hall if necessary and also after exiting the Drama Hall. I understand the temptation will be great to loiter and catch up with friends but you must not do this and we will sadly have to enforce your departure from the school site if this was to be the case.

Following guidance we must insist that parents/carers do not gather at entrance gates or doors or enter the school site so if they come with you they must wait on the bus bay.

This model ensures students have limited time to wait and do not have to return to the school site for later appointments. We anticipate enrolment will in most cases be very straightforward given programmes have already been largely finalised and you have already completed bridging work. However, there may be some circumstances in which a student wishes to digest their results and schedule an appointment later that day, between 1.00pm and 4.00pm. You can make these appointments with Dr Dando on exiting the Drama Hall.

**We strongly advise students to enrol at the time of collecting the results.**
